



Integrated Component System (ICS) Fleet Warranty

*for Digitally Imaged Graphics Manufactured using
Gandinnovations Solvent Printer with HL V2 Solvent Inks*

Avery Dennison warrants that the following Avery brand marking films:

**MPI 1005, 1005 EZ, 1005 EZ RS, 1007, 1007EZ, 1007 EZ RS,
2003 EZ, 2003 EZ RS, 2010, Premium Reflective, DOL 1000/1100**

will perform and provide "outdoor durability(1)" for the period stated in the corresponding Product Data Bulletin from the date of application under normal vertical exposure conditions provided that the film is properly stored and is applied within one year of the original shipment date from Avery Dennison. This warranty is contingent on the Avery Dennison material being processed using only Avery Dennison approved inks(2), premask, and associated processing materials in accordance with Avery Dennison recommended written processing instructions, and being applied to properly prepared surfaces and cleaned and maintained in accordance with recommended Avery Dennison application procedures.

"Outdoor Durability" for the purpose of this warranty is defined as no appreciable deterioration in the product when viewed from its intended viewing distance. Premature failure due to cracking, crazing, blistering, or loss of adhesion shall constitute a breach of warranty if it occurs during the warranty period. Replacement graphics will be warranted for the period corresponding to the remaining warranty period of the original failed graphics. Slight color fading, chalking, edge lifting, "tenting" around rivets, or slight reduction in gloss (for cast and calendared films) or reflectivity (for retroreflective films) will not materially detract from appearance and does not constitute a breach of warranty. In the event a breach of warranty occurs as defined above, Avery Dennison's sole liability is outlined below.

A. Warranty Against Processing Failure

Replacement of film and processing components in an amount equal to the value of the materials that failed during processing. It is the graphic manufacturers responsibility to perform incoming raw material quality inspections, to implement appropriate manufacturing process controls including in-process testing, retain converted samples, and to immediately cease using and notify Avery Dennison of any materials deemed defective.

B. Warranty Against Performance Failure

Replacement of defective Avery branding marking films material plus reimbursement for a portion of the following documented expected (3) "Customer Costs:" direct costs (inks, premask, labor) of reprocessing, removal of defective material and reapplication of replacement material. Avery Dennison will reimburse 100% of such Customer Costs for the first half of the warranty period (4). For failures during the second half of the graphics warranted life Customer Costs reimbursement will be calculated using the following formula:

$$\$ = A \times \frac{2(B - C)}{B} \quad \text{Where} \quad \begin{array}{l} A = \text{Actual Customer Costs (as defined in this section)} \\ B = \text{Warranty period (months)} \\ C = \text{Number of months since application} \end{array}$$

C. Removal Warranty (MPI 2010, Premium Reflective)

Avery Dennison will reimburse documented excess costs actually incurred beyond anticipated normal removal costs for Avery Dennison materials designated as "removable." Removable products are guaranteed to leave no more than 20% adhesive residue when removed per Avery Dennison written removal procedures. Reimbursement of "excess costs" shall not exceed the value of the film for which warranty coverage is claimed.

D. Removal Warranty (MPI 1005, MPI 1005 EZ, 1005 EZ RS, 1007EZ, 1007 EZ RS, 2003 EZ, 2003 EZ RS)

Avery Dennison will reimburse documented excess costs actually incurred beyond anticipated normal removal costs for Avery Dennison materials designated as "removable". MPI 1005 Fleet Marking Films and MPI 1005 EZ Fleet Marking Films are guaranteed to be 100% removable for the life of the printed graphic when removed per Avery Dennison written removal procedures. Reimbursement of "excess costs" shall not exceed the value of the film for which warranty coverage is claimed.



Notification of Claim

This ICS Warranty requires that Avery Dennison is notified in writing of any claims within fourteen days of material failure. Claim notifications must include name and lot numbers for films and processing components, report of processing conditions and in-process test results, finished decal retain samples, installation date and location, name of graphic installer, and any other pertinent information requested by Avery Dennison. Avery Dennison reserves the right to inspect all reported claims. Failure to comply constitutes a waiver of all rights under this ICS Warranty. *This ICS Warranty applies to Avery specified graphics programs only. All new applications using over \$25,000.00 of Avery Dennison materials require warranty confirmation and registration.*

Application to Glass

Avery Dennison accepts no liability for glass breakage. Glass is prone to break under the stresses caused by temperature changes across the surface, which could be amplified by the application of vinyl film.

Misuse and Force Majeure

Avery Dennison has no obligations under this warranty with respect to products that have been modified or damaged through misuse, abuse, accident, neglect, or mishandling by Purchaser or Purchaser's customer. For example, unless specifically claimed in an Avery Dennison Product or Instructional Bulletin, graphics are not warranted against premature failure caused by chemical or mechanical means such as, but not limited to, vandalism, cleaning solutions, paints, solvents, improperly used high pressure washing equipment, mechanical washing equipment, engine fuel spills, engine exhaust, steam, organic solvents or other spilled chemicals. Graphics applied to unsound surfaces or surfaces, which subsequently crack, peel, outgas, or become damaged beneath the graphic, are not warranted for performance. Damage from fire, structural failure, lightning, and other force majeure events are not covered.

Unintended Use of Products

Avery Dennison products covered by this warranty are intended only for use by professional users and only for the intended uses as described in the corresponding Avery Dennison Product Data Bulletins. Before using for any other application, user shall determine the suitability of the product for its intended use and user assumes all risk and liability in connection therewith.

Warranted outdoor durability coverage for Avery MPI films printed on approved digital printers using OEM inks and Avery approved graphics protection systems (1) (2) (3) (4) (5) (6).

- Assuming vertical exposure: Outdoor durability for the following extremely severe areas will be 20% the durability published in the appropriate Product Data Bulletin: AZ, NV, NM, UT, s TX, s CA, s FL, Mexico, Caribbean Isle. Reference Instructional Bulletin # 1.30 for durability guidelines.
- Horizontal applications are not warranted, recommended, and do not have any expectations of durability. The exposure of films in the horizontal position invalidates any performance expectations as outlined in appropriate Product Data Bulletins and Instructional Bulletins. Films may retain legibility, but will not provide published Expected Durability for gloss, color retention, chalking, and overall aesthetic performance. Reference Instructional Bulletin #1.30 - Durability of Avery Dennison Film.
- If the stated durability of an approved allied component (ink, qualified clearcoat) differs from that of the Avery Dennison material the finished graphics will be warranted for a period equal to the stated durability of the least durable component.
- Liquid clearcoat application must be done using a qualified clearcoat system. See Instructional Bulletin # 5.92.
- Consult Avery Dennison ICS Cross-Reference Bulletin for a listing of Avery Dennison approved processing components.
- *Expected* Customer Costs will be determined by Avery Dennison on a case-by-case basis taking into account the amount of labor reasonably needed to make necessary repairs.
